Personal Safety

The Calgary Police Service would like to remind the public to guard against residential break-ins.

- Install exterior lights to brighten dark areas around doors or windows to make them more easily seen by passersby.
- Keep house doors locked when you're inside. When you're out in your back yard, keep your front door and windows locked — and vice versa. Also, keep garage doors closed and locked.
- Always close and lock any windows that could be used to gain access to your home while you're sleeping.
- Store important or irreplaceable documents and items away from your home, such as in a safety deposit box.
- Disconnect the garage door opener by switching on its "lock" setting or switching off the circuit breaker that allows the automatic door to open. Place a padlock in the door track to block the roller. Lock all person-doors, including the one between an attached garage and the house.
- Lock up tools, BBQs and ladders and make sure they are out of sight.
